MEDITATION OF THE DAY

SAINT MAXIMUS OF TURIN - *Saint Maximus of Turin († 5th century) was the first bishop of Turin, Italy, and an outstanding biblical scholar and preacher.*

Rejoice and Be Glad!

Not without cause is the psalm read today in which the prophet orders exultation and jubilation. For holy David invites all creatures to the celebration of this day. On this day the underworld is opened by Christ's Resurrection, the earth is renewed by the Church's neophytes, and heaven is unlocked by the Holy Spirit. At last the thief ascends into paradise, the bodies of the saints enter into the holy city, the dead turn into the living. By one and the same operation the Savior's suffering lifts up from the depths, raises up from the earth, and gathers in the heights. For Christ's Resurrection is life to the dead, pardon to sinners, and glory to the saints. Therefore holy David invites every creature to the celebration of Christ's Resurrection, for he says that there must be exultation and jubilation on this day that the Lord has made. For the light of Christ is not obstructed by walls, not divided by the elements, and not obscured by darkness. The light of Christ, I say, is a day without night, a day without end; everywhere it shines, everywhere it radiates, nowhere does it fail. The light of Christ is always brilliant, radiant, and gleaming, and no gloom of sinfulness can encompass it, which is why the Evangelist John says: *And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not grasp it (1:5).*

Therefore we ought all to rejoice on this holy day. Let no one draw back from the common celebration because of his awareness of sin. Let no one stand off from the public acts of worship because of his burden of crimes. Although one may be a sinner, on this day he ought not to despair of pardon. This is no small privilege. If even the thief merited paradise, why should not the Christian merit pardon? And if the Lord, when he is crucified, has mercy on the former, will he not all the more have mercy on the latter when he rises?

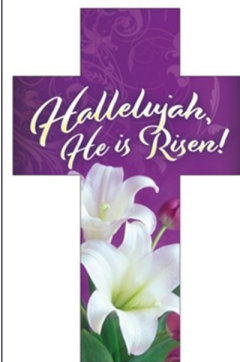
Top Reasons to Register at a Parish
