“Nevertheless steps should be taken so that the faithful may also be able to say or to sing together in Latin those parts of the *Ordinary of the Mass* which pertain to them.”

*Sacrosanctum Concilium, 54*

“The Church acknowledges Gregorian chant as specially suited to the Roman liturgy: therefore, other things being equal, it should be given pride of place in liturgical services.”
